



## EXPLORE FIJI'S ISLANDS & CORAL REEFS

### Fishing Action

Enjoy great Sportfishing, trolling lures and deadbaits for Spanish mackerel, Yellowfin tuna and Mahimahi, and exciting Light tackle action, with Giant trevally (catch and release), Bluefin trevally and more.

Sportfishing trips run to the barrier reef early mornings and afternoons for three and a half hours. Up to four anglers can share the boat.

Light tackle trips run for three hours in the afternoon and combine popper fishing (casting) and trolling on the reefs around Tokoriki. We recommend a maximum of two anglers on Light tackle fishing charters.

All tackle is provided, and we are happy to take beginners. Let us know if you need us to link you up with others.

### Boat Transfers

We offer a daily water taxi service to other island resorts in the region, as well as a link up with the Yasawa Islands daily ferry.

If you haven't planned how to get to your next destination, this option could be time saving, affording you more flexibility to get on with enjoying your holiday.

### Booking

We advise you to book your tour in advance to secure your place on the boat.

### Local Village Visit

A trip to Fiji is not complete without a visit to a Fijian village. Yanuya village is a short boat ride away and located in a spectacular setting. Enjoy a guided stroll along leafy paths and learn about village life. Highlights include a visit to the school, meeting the school kids and shopping in the local handicraft market.

### Monuriki 'Cast Away' Tour and Guided Snorkel

This stunning island, used as a movie location, is so popular it even has it's own Wikipedia page! Monuriki is a land and marine reserve. Visitors can enjoy a fast boat ride past turquoise bays, breathtaking beaches and islands, a guided nature walk, followed by an easy snorkel with a marine guide straight off the beach.

### Champagne Island Hopping to Cloud9

Your ticket to a great day out which includes stopping off at a sand bar for breathtaking snorkeling and visiting Cloud9 - a floating bar with 360 degree views of ocean and surrounding islands. Lunch and drinks at Cloud9 are at extra cost.

### Snorkel Safari

If you're a keen snorkeler wanting to get off the beaten track then look no further. Two great offshore reefs with lovely coral and good opportunities to see turtles and reef sharks. A qualified marine guide is in the water with you to show you the best spots and point out interesting aquatic life.

### PADI Discover Scuba Diving

A fun and easy way to try diving for the first time. Under the guidance of a PADI Instructor, enjoy a short complimentary pool lesson, followed up by a dive. The program takes 2.5 hours and will allow you to continue diving during your stay.

### PADI Guided Snorkel for Beginners

A chance to visit Tokoriki's marine reserve with a personal guide in-water with you. Your PADI guide will help you understand the basics with a snorkel swimming pool lesson, before introducing you to the wonders of the reef. Not suitable for non swimmers.

### Private Itineraries and Charters

Arrange to go surfing on Cloud Break or take a transfer and explore the majestic Southern Yasawas. If getting off the beaten track is your thing why not arrange for a private charter up to the Sacred Islands. Visit Mana Sandbar, or do any of our tried and tested tours, but arrange to do so privately.
