Speak to any Dive Professional and they'll tell you that the Rescue Diver course marked the changing point in their diving capabilities. It is a confidence boosting course...Rescue divers are characteristically in control, calm, safe and caring divers.

The Rescue diver course is full of challenges and hands on learning experiences—it's also a lot of fun! The course involves learning 10 in-water rescue skills which are then tried and tested in 4 Open water Rescue scenarios/dives. The Rescue Diver Course does require the participant to have completed the theory online through PADI eLearning before arrival at Tokoriki.

- Allow at least 5 full diving days for completion.
- Participants must be medically fit to scuba dive.

- Booking is essential to allow for an Instructor to be available for your stay.

PRE REQUISITE CERTIFICATIONS

- Student must be at least PADI Advanced Open Water, or have qualifying certification from another training organization.
- Must have proof of at least 20 logged dives, documenting experience in deep diving and underwater navigation.
- Student must have successfully completed a sanctioned course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and basic first aid within the past two years. Proof of this must be provided prior to certification.
